ABOUT LDW

Leadership Development Workshop (LDW) assists young professionals in developing leadership competencies and building relationships to grow in their careers and the community. Delivered through classroom-based and experiential learning, LDW will require six half-day sessions & some small group work between sessions.

Participants will develop skills such as: leading through authentic relationships, building trust and accountability, aligning leadership with core values, solving problems interdependently, creating professional networks for collaboration, and achieving emotional strength. LDW will provide a broad perspective on Gratiot County, including quality of life components, economic background, current issues, and future opportunities.

Sessions are designed and facilitated by Vicki Pontz, Founder and President of MindFull Strategies. Ms. Pontz served in leadership positions in the private sector, state government, and academic settings for over 30 years. She co-designed and directed the Great Lakes Leadership Academy at Michigan State University. Ms. Pontz also received the 2022 Governor William Milliken Leadership for the Common Good Award.

Ashley Tupper will serve as a co-facilitator for this course. Ms. Tupper received a Bachelor of Science in business administration and Master of Science in Leadership from CMU. She currently works at 3one3 Boutique Hotel as General Manager and Child Advocacy as Family Resource Coordinator, in addition to serving as the Co-Chair for GYPN.
